This is often a forgotten resource that we all need to know how to use so I'm going to walk you through some of the pages:

Navigate to https://billingsemmaus.com

1: You find yourself on the "Home" page where you will find

- "Men's and Women's Prayer Vigils"
 - o sign up here for upcoming weekends
- Printable Sponsor & Pilgrim Applications"
 - o Paper Applications for both Sponsor and Pilgrims are for reference only. <u>Please do not submit paper applications</u>. Use these to collect information that you will enter into the "online applications".
- "Online Sponsor & Pilgrim Application" Required
 - Why is this required online over paper? Because often, when we get paper, we cannot read the handwriting, and things are inaccurate. We have had very few errors since going electronic and we appreciate this new process for the registration team.

- "What happens at Emmaus"
 - o Click on the link and find a **pamphlet** to share with potential pilgrims.
- Family & Friends Prayer Request Sheet
 - O This is a great resource for gathering names from Pilgrims. I often tell my pilgrim that I will be calling these people to ask them to pray for the pilgrim. Then, when I contact family/friends, I always share that the pilgrim knows I'm calling to request prayers, but that it will be a wonderful **surprise** if they send cards and letters to me.
- How to Donate to WTE
- 2: Go to the **menu** at the top of the home page. Click on the "About" tab and find the Board Members.
- 3: Go to the menu at the top of the home page. Click on the "Weekends" tab
 - "Walk" This will show upcoming weekends (this information will be updated during early summer for the coming year.)
- **4:** Go to the **menu** at the top of the home page. Click on "Community"
 - "Events" gives you upcoming dates
 - "Newsletters" Oh man, did you realize you can get to old newsletters??? WOW, so now you should never miss a newsletter; even if you don't check your email, you can always come here and catch up on the latest news about the WTE Community. I challenge you to review this section and ask other community members if they know about it.
 - "Prayer Requests"
 - "Volunteering" You will see where you can help. Do you remember how amazing your weekend was? Well, behind the scenes were hundreds of volunteers, and without them, our W2E weekends wouldn't be possible, so we need all of you!
